Best Researcher Award (2015)

Eligibility and guidelines:

- Any faculty member of science, engineering, medical and pharmaceutical departments of Panjab University is eligible for this award.
- Award selection will be based on the cumulative impact factor (latest available) of all publications of the nominee for those papers that were published during 1st January 2015 and 31st December 2015.
- Only those publications in which applicant's affiliation is Panjab University and the applicant is a corresponding and/or first author (in same preference order) will be used for the calculation of the cumulative impact factor. Review publications or book chapters etc. will not be considered. The applicant with the highest cumulative impact factor number will be selected for the award. The first page of all publications must be submitted along with application form.
- The number of award is one per year and award amount is Rs. 30,000/-. The award will be presented during Prof. R. C. Paul National Conference of Chemistry department and the awardee is expected to make an oral presentation after receiving the award.

Best Publication Award (2015)

Eligibility and guidelines:

- All the faculty members of science, engineering, medical and pharmaceutical departments of Panjab University who have published research paper(s) with an impact factor of 5.0 and above are eligible for this award.
- Only those paper(s) that are published between 1st January 2015 and 31st December 2015 will be considered. If multiple papers from the same author are available for the same year, all of them will be treated as separate entries.
- The published work should be based on applicant's research work and the applicant should be a corresponding and/or first author (in same preference order) in the publication. Review publications or book chapters etc. will not be considered.
- Maximum of six awards per year can be given and the award amount is Rs. 5000/- per paper. If there are more than six applications, the highest impact factor applications will be considered.
- The award will be presented during CHASCON or any other seminar in the Science Departments of the University.

The last date of receiving nomination/applications for the above awards is 15th September 2016. There should be separate applications for each award.
